## KPDNHEP tambah baik dasar kerajaan terdahulu

**Putrajaya:** Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Hal Ehwal Pengguna (KPDNHEP) akan meneruskan dasar dan strategi sedia ada yang baik oleh kerajaan terdahulu dan menambah baik aspek yang perlu.

Menterinya Datuk Alexander Nanta Linggi (*gambar*) yang memulakan tugas semalam berkata, sememangnya masih ada ruang dan peluang untuk penambahbaikan kepada strategi atau dasar yang boleh mensejahterakan rakyat memandangkan keutamaan Kementerian adalah rakyat.

"Jadi kita sepatutnya buat dasar yang boleh membantu meringankan beban rakyat dan juga me-

reka yang terbabit dalam perdagangan dalam negeri," katanya.

## KPDNHEP Putrajaya rampas 429 tong LPG

**Klang:** Tidak sempat melarikan diri apabila tiga 'dalang' sindiket penyelewengan tong gas petroleum cecair (LPG) subsidi berjaya diberkas dalam serbuan mengejut, semalam.

Dalam operasi bermula jam 2.30 petang, sepasukan anggota Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Hal Ehwal Pengguna (KPDNHEP) Putrajaya berjaya merampas 429 tong LPG susulan serbuan di tiga premis di Kampung Sungai Pinang Dalam di sini.

Timbalan Pengarah Penguatkuasa KPDNHEP Putrajaya, Azman Adam berkata, ketiga-tiga premis yang diserbu serentak itu disyaki satu rangkaian

yang membekalkan gas subsidi diseleweng untuk pasaran kawasan sekitar.

"Dalam serbuan di premis pertama, kami merampas beberapa dokumen yang membuktikan bahawa mereka membekalkan tong gas LPG ke beberapa tempat.

"Hasil maklumat itu, kami berjaya menyerbu premis kedua dan mendapati berlaku aktiviti memindahkan gas subsidi. Jadi kami merampas 194 tong gas LPG (14 kg), 59 tong (50 kg), sebuah lori serta dua penimbang.

"Seterusnya kami ke premis ketiga dan merampas 176 tong gas LPG (50 kg). Jumlah keseluruhan rampasan dianggarkan bernilai RM130,000," katanya.

## Govt may consider floor prices for fuel to help traders

**PUTRAJAYA:** Calls to impose a floor price for petrol and diesel due to plummeting global oil prices will be looked into, says Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Minister Datuk Alexander Nanta Linggi.

"We will listen to all recommendations. If it is good, we recommend it to the government.

"But it is too early for me to say. This needs in-depth discussion,"

Nanta said after attending a welcoming ceremony for him and his deputy, Datuk Rosol Wahid, at the ministry here yesterday.

Nanta was responding to a suggestion by petrol dealers that the government introduce a floor price for petrol and diesel to prevent losses to traders.

Last week, the price of RON95 petrol was reduced by 18 sen to RM1.89 per litre.

Diesel went down by 17 sen to RM1.96 per litre.

On the targeted petrol subsidy scheme proposed by the Pakatan Harapan government, Nanta said he would discuss with ministry officers on whether it would be continued.

"If anything that is already in place or was proposed ... if they are good for the rakyat then we will keep it, why not?"

"Whatever policies and strategies that are already in place will be retained. There is definitely room for improvement as well.

"Our core business is the rakyat and we must come up with policies that can help ease their burden," said Nanta.

The five-term Kapit MP said as a minister from Sarawak, there were high expectations from the people, especially those in rural areas.

Nanta however said his services would not just be for the people in his home state.

"I am a minister for Malaysia. In the context of Sarawak, there are

expectations that this ministry can help them, especially with the cost of living.

"As you know, many in Sarawak live in remote places. I will do my best," he said.

Nanta is one of the four MPs from Gabungan Parti Sarawak appointed as ministers in the new Perikatan Nasional Cabinet.

Under the Barisan Nasional government, Nanta served as deputy minister of rural and regional development.
